Come and help Ride the Ruby Country control ragwort in some parts of Ruby Country.

Saturday 16th July Colesmill Stables, Holsworthy 10.30am to 4pm

Ragwort is poisonous to livestock of all kinds but particularly horses. Ragwort spreads easily and rapidly, with each flower producing hundreds of seeds blown to new sites by the wind.

Ride the Ruby Country has teamed up with Colesmill Stables, Cornwall Farmers, Forestry Commission and a wide range of equestrian and other interest groups from across Ruby Country to raise awareness of the problem of ragwort and the need for its control. Control teams will set out from Colesmill Stables to identified areas to remove ragwort and help protect the health of horses.
