
North of Pyworthy - in the west of Ruby Country

1. Starting from Pyworthy Church, go past the Primary School and cross the road looking for a public footpath sign. Once reached, take this path and very soon the path forks. Take the right hand fork. Follow this footpath which will join a tarmac lane, coming to a property and workshop.

Keep to the right hand footpath close to the hedge. Very soon a stile is reached across which is a field. Cross the field heading slightly left, coming to a short bridge and stile into another field. Cross this field to the far left corner. Pass through a gate onto a grassy track. Follow this track uphill and look out for a sign post directing the path left over the route of the old railway line. To the right can be seen a bridge which also crossed the railway line.

- 2. On the left is Villavin Farm. Turn right and go along the tarmac road away from the farm. Keep straight on this road past Killatree Farm until a public road is reached.
- **3.** Turn left along the road. Along this road is Holsworthy Golf Course to the right of the road, with farmland on the left. Keep on this road until a bungalow is passed. Look out for a footpath sign guiding the route over a stile into a field on the left.
- **4.** Cross straight over this field and look for a narrow pathway, then pass through a gate. Cross the grassy track, again the route of the old railway line. And through a gate into another field.

Keep the hedge close on the left hand side and head towards the house at the top of the field. Go through the next gate and walk up the track to the left of the house. This track leads back to Pyworthy, just across the road from the Primary School.
